Learn Anytime Update

Beginning Summer 2010, JCTC Learn Anytime courses must be completed within 120 days instead of the former 150 days. The reason for this change is to streamline Learn Anytime courses in line with regular semester-based courses. All enrollment confirmation communication via email now clarifies the 120-day timeframe, and students are still given 14 days to drop without penalty for any reason, including if

the adjusted timeframe will not work for them.

Metropolitan College students are reminded to check with Student Development Counselors to ensure the appropriate student agreement is signed to cover the cost of the Learn Anytime courses. For specific Learn Anytime questions, students are encouraged to email LearnAnytime@kctcs.edu.

JCTC Scholarship Opportunity

The Grainger Tools for Tomorrow Scholarship is being made available to JCTC students. Eligible students must be entering their final year of technical education studies at JCTC in the fall of 2010. Areas of study include electronic systems, HVAC/R, plumbing, welding, construction, automotive or other industrial trade.

To apply, you must be a full-time student, must maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher, submit an essay and letter of

Metropolitan College Summer Tuition Policy Change

Effective summer 2010, Metropolitan College participants will be permitted to enroll up to the maximum number of credits allowed by their academic institution (JTC or UofL) in the summer terms. Students should meet with an academic adviser at their institution to determine the appropriate number of credits for their individual academic plan.

The summer tuition benefit will be limited to the regular per credit hour undergraduate KY resident tuition applicable for the institution in which the student is enrolled (including the JTC security fee). The commitment for tuition benefit for students at either institution, or for those who are dually enrolled at JTC and UofL, may not exceed the equivalent of full-time regular undergraduate Kentucky resident tuition at the University of Louisville (including the JTC security fee).

Prior to summer 2010, MC participants were limited to six credit hours paid by MC/UPS in the summer if they had enrolled full-time in the fall and spring semesters. This change was approved by the Metropolitan College Council in an effort to assist students to attain their academic credentials in a timely manner.

JTC-SW Summer Office Hours

The Metropolitan College office at JTC-Southwest will operate on a summer schedule May 10 through July 30. The office will be open on Mondays from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. and Tuesdays from 9 a.m. - 6 p.m.

Summer Financial Aid Information

JTC - Students must have a complete 2009-2010 FAFSA on file AND submit a JTC Summer 2010 Financial Aid application, which is available at http://www.jefferson.kctcs.edu/Costs_and_Financial_Aid/Financial_Aid_Office/Financial_Aid_Forms.aspx.

Students should register for summer classes prior to June 9 and submit the JTC Summer 2010 Financial Aid application after they have registered for classes. The Financial Aid office will not adjust student's award for class additions that occur.

University of Louisville - The application for Summer 2010 federal financial aid will be on student's ULink account in April.

Students must have a complete 2009-2010 Financial Aid File, which includes a 2009-2010 FAFSA and all requested documentation, to apply. Students should not apply on ULink until they have finalized their summer enrollment.
